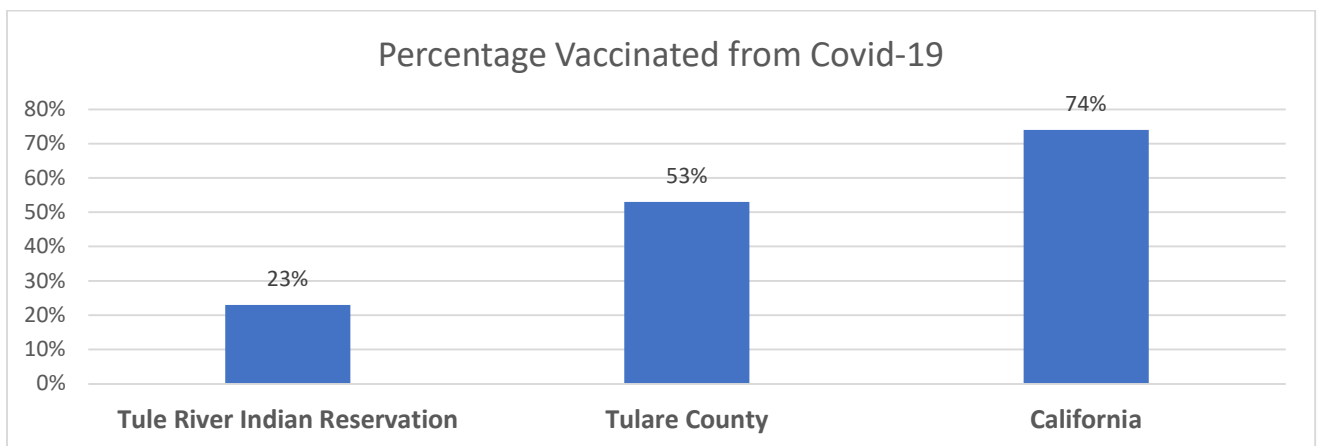
Key Takeaways

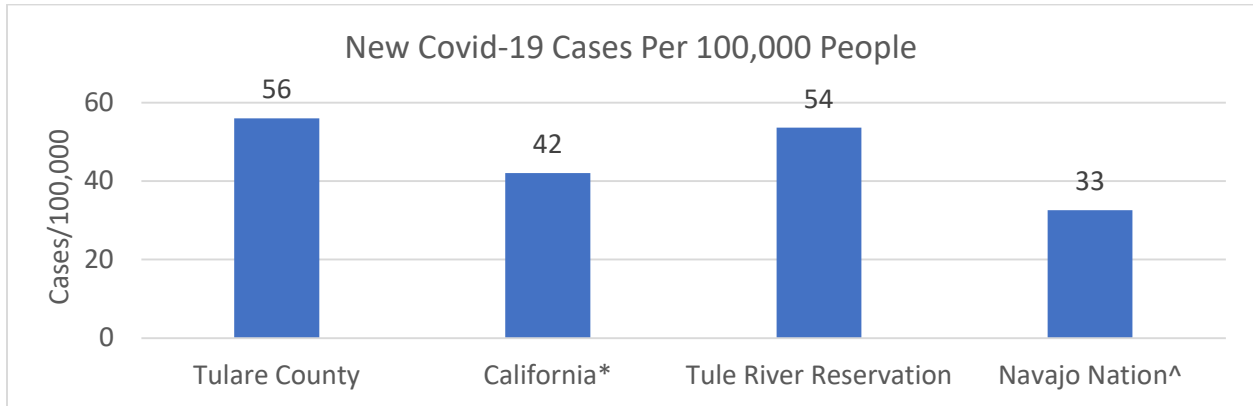

Off Reservation: **--**



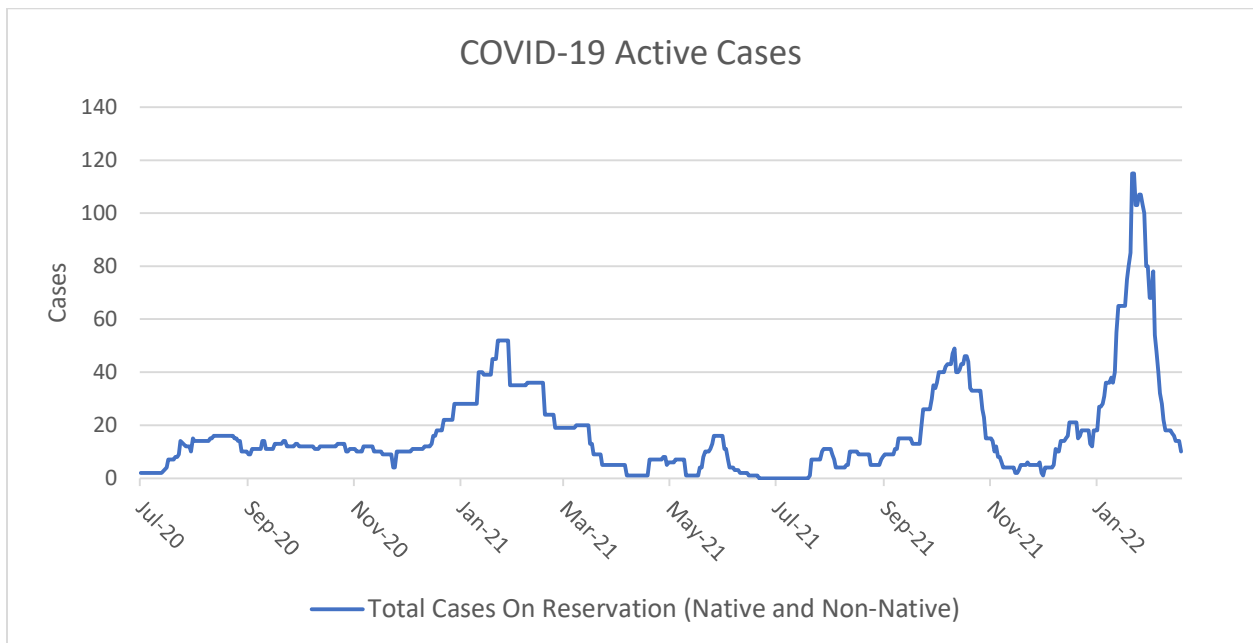
“New cases” are everyone who tests positive for Covid-19 for the first time within the last 7 days. The graph below compares the rate of new cases with other areas.

Active Cases

Active Positive Cases: 10 on & off reservation



“Active cases” are everyone that currently has Covid-19 on the reservation. This number is different from new cases because active cases may have first tested positive more than a week ago. New cases are only those that have tested positive within the last week.

Cumulative Cases

Cumulative Positive Cases*: UNKNOWN (-- on & -- off reservation)

Recovered:[†] UNKNOWN (-- on & -- off reservation)

Deaths: 10

Cumulative cases are all cases of Covid-19 diagnosed at the Tule River Indian Health Center of residents of the reservation or other patients of the center.

Quarantine

Number in Quarantine: UNKNOWN

Quarantined individuals are those with a known direct exposure to a positive case of Covid-19. They are ordered to stay within their residence or another facility for up to 14 days.

Citations

To date, the Tule River Tribal Police have issued **8 citations** for not complying with PHA Orders.
