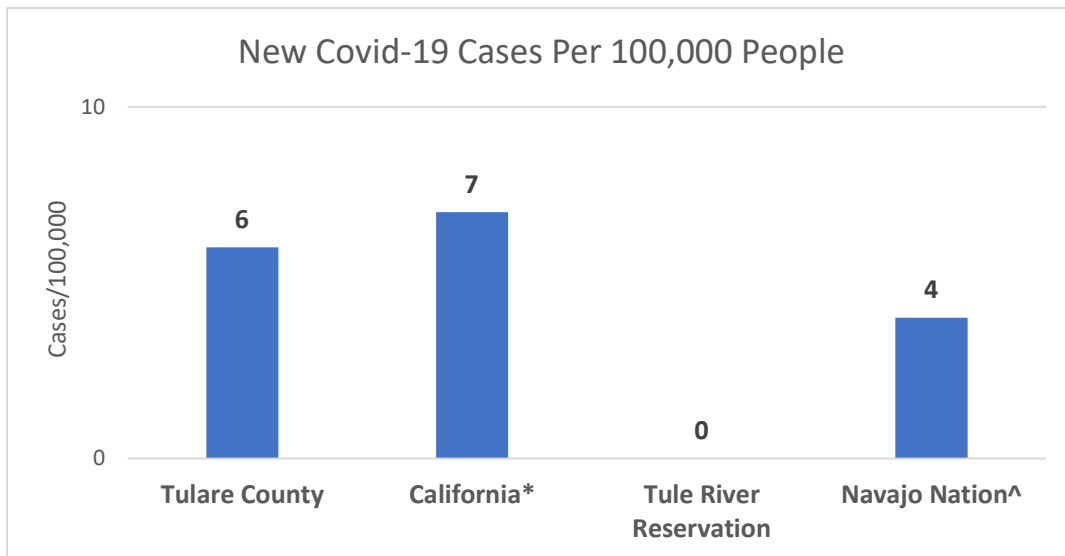
- 0 new positive case in the last week on the Tule River Indian Reservation, which has held steady since the last report.

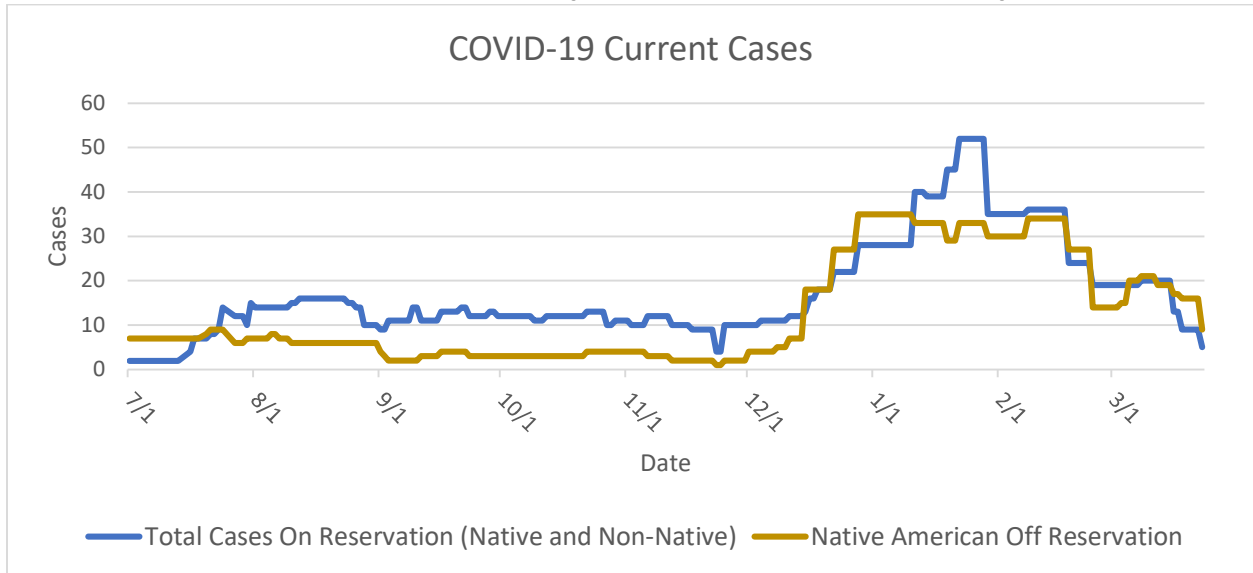

Active Cases

Active Positive Cases: 14 (5 on & 9 off reservation)



“Active cases” are everyone that currently has Covid-19 on the reservation. This number is different from new cases because active cases may have first tested positive more than a week ago. New cases are only those that have tested positive within the last week.

Cumulative Cases

Cumulative Positive Cases*: 400 (202 on & 198 off reservation)
Recovered:† 385 (196 on & 189 off reservation)
Deaths: 1

Cumulative cases are all cases of Covid-19 diagnosed at the Tule River Indian Health Center of residents of the reservation or other patients of the center.

Quarantine

Number in Quarantine: 21 (10 on & 11 off reservation)

Quarantined individuals are those with a known direct exposure to a positive case of Covid-19. They are ordered to stay within their residence or another facility for up to 14 days.

* Total Cases include all residents of the Tule River Indian Reservation and Native non-residents

† Recovered includes those that are or lost to follow-up and have been released with doctor’s permission.
