

#### **New Cases**

**New Cases Last 7 Days** 

On Reservation: **19** Off Reservation: **10** 


"New cases" are everyone who tests positive for Covid-19 for the first time within the last 7 days. The graph below compares the rate of new cases with other areas.



#### **Active Cases**

#### Active Positive Cases: 71 (40 on & 31 off reservation)

"Active cases" are everyone that currently has Covid-19 on the reservation. This number is different from new cases because active cases may have first tested positive more than a week ago. New cases are only those that have tested positive within the last week.



#### **Cumulative Cases**

**Cumulative Positive Cases\*: 292** 

Recovered:<sup>†</sup> 220 (115 on & 105 off reservation)

Deaths: 1

Cumulative cases are all cases of Covid-19 diagnosed at the Tule River Indian Health Center of residents of the reservation or other patients of the center.

#### Quarantine

Number in Quarantine: Currently Unknown

Quarantined individuals are those with a known direct exposure to a positive case of Covid-19. They are ordered to stay within their residence or another facility for up to 14 days.
